# REMEMBERING ROBERTA BITGOOD

Roberta Bitgood, whom many attendees of St. Dunstan's School of Sacred Music over the years will remember for her pithy words of wisdom, died in April at the age of 99. She is remembered by one of her protégés, Diana Norton-Jackson:

Roberta Bitgood was truly one of my heroes. She was a pioneer for women in the organ profession as the first woman to earn a doctorate at Union Seminary's Institute of Sacred Music and the first woman to be national president of the AGO. A talented and busy lady, she visited 125 chapters in the US during her long term in office with the AGO, still finding time to help a young organist in Kingston, RI, give good advice, and share music in a most generous way. As a composer, recitalist, and full-time church organist and choirmaster, her energy and dedication were astounding.

Before she moved to a nursing home, my husband and I were able to have a nice visit with her at her home in Quaker Hill, CT. When she was no longer able to correspond herself, her daughter helped send out her Christmas letters to hundreds of people. She touched the lives of thousands of musicians, parishioners and concert goers during her long professional life. She will be missed by so many of us who were privileged to know her.
